Northeastern Utah Educational Services (NUES) is presently accepting applications for the position of Regional Technology Trainer. This will be a ten-month (210 working days) position beginning September 1, 2018.

Under the direction of the Executive Director and the Board, the NUES Regional Technology Trainer provides a wide variety of technical training to administrators, teachers and staff within the NUES region with on-going support and follow-up. The trainer also promotes the use of the educational technology in the classroom and trains teachers how to access and use technology to improve instruction and student learning. Training educators on the use of formative assessment and utilizing student assessment data is a major priority of the position.

Required qualifications include a Bachelor's degree and valid Utah Educator's license with three years of classroom teaching experience (or equivalent industry technical training experience), demonstrated customer service, communication (written, verbal and electronic), teaming, organization, problem solving, prioritizing and computer/technology integration skills. Preference will be given to candidates with a strong background in educational uses of mobile technologies (iPads/iPods/smart phones), interactive white boards and response systems, Canvas and presenting. Preference will also be given to candidates with an education technology endorsement and/or a Master's degree in education technology.
